

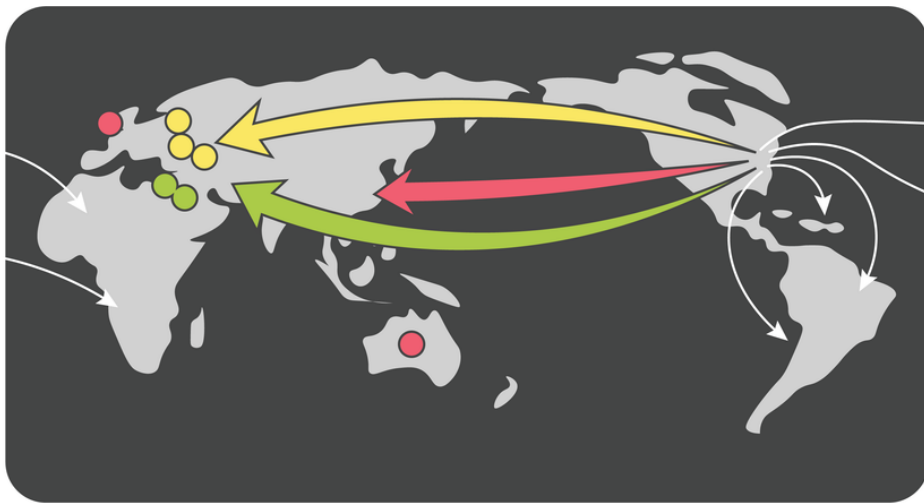

BACKGROUND

In today's global geopolitical situation, three "fronts of US-Led war" are emerging, aimed at preserving sole US hegemony: the US-Western alliance including NATO for Eastern Europe against Russia; the US-NATO-Israel-Saudi alliance against Iran; and Australia-UK-US (AUKUS) against China-DPRK. At the same time, US-led war and aggression also operates all over Africa, Latin America and the Caribbean.

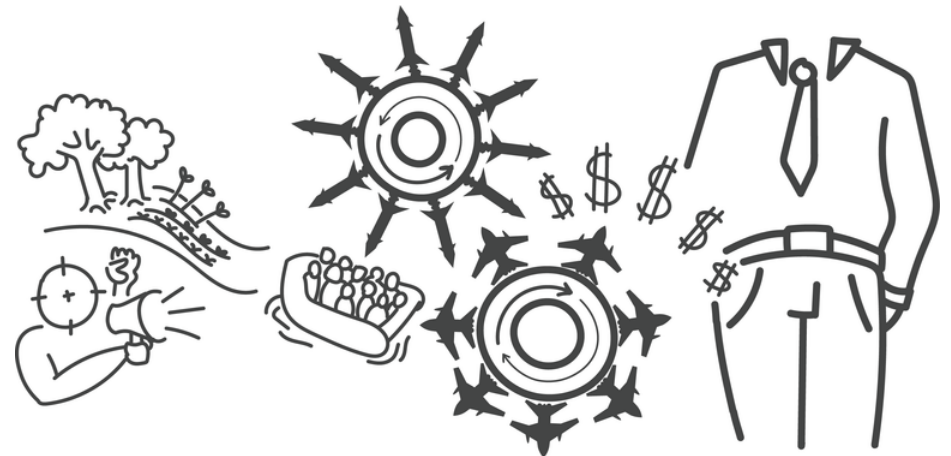


- US-Western alliance against Russia

- US-NATO-Israel-Saudi against Iran

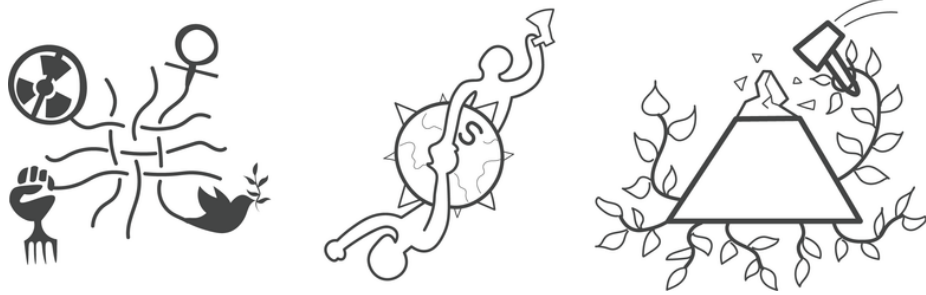
US-led war and aggression all over Africa, Latin America and the Caribbean

The people, especially the working class, are gravely affected by war—not the government executives, military generals, bankers, business owners or weapons suppliers who profit from war. Wars of aggression displace indigenous people, destroy arable land for farmers and food production, contribute to the climate crisis, function to keep poor nations oppressed under US imperialism, and target revolutionaries through state repression by their local reactionary ruling class and imperialist puppet masters.

As more wars break out and the people face intensified repression, we must strengthen movements against imperialist war and build solidarity with people's movements asserting their collective democratic rights, self-determination, and social and national liberation.



2023: PRIORITIES FOR THE MOVEMENT



Build a multi-national, multi-sectoral and multi-issue mass movement in resistance to all manifestations of US-led war and militarism

War and militarism impact all people around the world, from towns and cities reduced to rubble, to sanctions and food blockades depriving people of their means of livelihood, to militarist ideologies that engender violent attacks against youth and women, to ethno-nationalist and fascist subjugation of oppressed peoples and nations, to imperialist societies with bloated military budgets, to the twin threats of nuclear destruction and climate breakdown. Not all are affected equally, but all are affected for the benefit of the warmakers. We must be united against them, not each other!

Unite the peace movements within the US and Global North countries with the demands of Global South movements struggling for self-determination, peace and justice through internationally coordinated actions

US-led war may impact us all, but it most greatly affects those living within the colonial and neocolonial countries at the mercy of foreign military presence and local puppet rulers. For these and other oppressed peoples, peace is not abstract but instead tied inextricably to economic self-determination and political sovereignty. All those who wage peace must uplift the calls for sovereignty of all peoples against imperialist domination and those within imperialist societies must demand to their government rulers, "Not in our name!"

Highlight alternatives to the current social system that engenders war and militarism and fight for viable alternatives that engender peace

Build just peace through justice, social equity, and solidarity amongst peoples, including the recognition of the right to self-determination, economic, and food sovereignty, and self-defense of nations and oppressed peoples from reactionary aggression and violence. Build peace through genuine sustainable development, job creation, and the health and well being of our communities.

END ALL WARS OF AGGRESSION AND IMPERIALIST WARS

End the Proxy War in Ukraine!

The war has claimed over 100,000 lives and led to thousands of displaced and refugees, while inflation has skyrocketed due to the privatized and wasteful global supply chains the war has exposed. The US and NATO continue to pump weapons onto the battlefield in their goal to strategically weaken Russia while Ukrainians and Russians keep dying with no peace process in sight.

End the Inter-Imperialist Escalation with China!

The US has taken every move to paint the economic, diplomatic and military rise of China as “aggressive”, engendering a new Cold War mentality and preparing public support for a future war. The US arming of Taiwan to protect the world’s largest semiconductor producer is the strongest factor escalating the tensions between the two superpowers.

End the Murderous War on Yemen!

The Saudi-led Gulf State coalition against Yemen has waged a murderous air assault campaign since 2014 leveling whole cities and leading an economic blockade with the supposed aim of destroying pro-Iranian influence near the Suez Canal. It is estimated over 150,000 have been killed in airstrikes and over 227,000 have died from blockade-imposed famine and destroyed medical facilities. The US has claimed to have ended only “offensive” military support but any weapons given can be used by the Gulf coalition.

END MILITARY ALLIANCES

Shut Down AUKUS and Demilitarize Asia Pacific!

Dismantle NATO to Demilitarize Europe!

NATO's Eastward growth since the dissolution of the Soviet Union has since brought 3.3 million allied troops under command of the US-led alliance with 40,000 in Eastern Europe alone. The alliance stipulates enormous military budgets and has militarized whole communities surrounding NATO bases. Tensions between member states Greece and Turkiye have put civilians at risk of armed conflict, especially on Cyprus, while continued military buildup at the Eastern borders risks further provocation of counter moves by Russia.

Under the Australia-UK-US security pact, the promise for the US and UK to provide nuclear submarines to Australia is both an alarming threat of force towards China and a wasteful drainage of military spending for the Australian people. While not labeled as a military alliance, the Quadrilateral Security Dialogue (Quad) between the US, India, Japan and Australia further inflames tensions. The large list of US bilateral military agreements with countries in the region amounts to an unofficial military alliance in itself.

Stop the G7!

End the US-made Zionist-Gulf alliance!

The US has pivoted to Asia and has forged an unprecedented alliance between the repressive Gulf monarchies and the Zionist colonial regime of Israel to be its watchdog in West Asia. This has helped consolidate the violent occupation of Palestine, the murderous Saudi-led war on Yemen, and left war-torn and impoverished societies in Lebanon, Syria, Iraq, Somalia and Eritrea for the sake of countering Iran's regional influence.

The G7 countries (US, Canada, UK, France, Germany, Italy, Japan) represent some of the world's most powerful economies and also the most powerful militaries. Last year G7 meetings hosted by Germany oversaw an immense sanction regime against Russia and other US competitor states. This year Japan will see an increase in North American and European support for the further militarization of the Pacific led by the US and Japan to further the imperialist economic agenda in the region.

SHUT DOWN OVERSEAS BASES AND US COMMANDS

Reject the US 6th Fleet!

The US 6th Fleet is based throughout the Mediterranean and the European Arctic and is the US Navy's main fleet for Europe, Northern and Western Africa. It is one of the main drivers of navy base expansion in the region and is NATO's largest naval force. It has made invasive inroads into coastal Iberian, Aegean, Adriatic and Horn-of-Africa communities that have especially devastated small fishing economies. This act amounts to the basing of unwelcome US war vessels and bases in the seas of other nations!

Shut Down AFRICOM!

The most recent addition to the US military command structure in 2007, US Africa Command (Africom) is responsible for devastating covert operations in Nigeria, Somalia, Kenya, Uganda, South Sudan, Mali and many other countries. It has armed and trained local warlords and has even helped some come to power where they have brutalized their own people for personal interests. Without a formal US-led alliance centered on the African continent, Africom is the leading driver of US-led war here.

Free Puerto Rico, Hawai'i and Guahan from US Domination!

Whether states, "administrative territories" or otherwise, these nations are modern colonies and military strongholds of the US. Puerto Rico is littered with depleted uranium and chemical residue from bomb tests at Vieques and other untreated communities. Hawai'i houses more military sites than any US state and hosts the unwelcome and invasive Rim of the Pacific biennial joint military exercise. Guahan's use as a lily pad stop for military refueling has left its economy neglected and its citizens without any say in their country's political status.

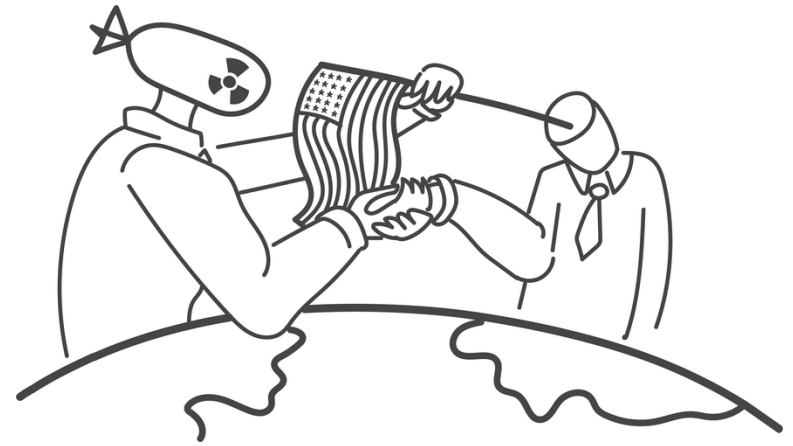
Close all Overseas US and Allied Bases!

Overseas bases are a violation of the self-determination of nations in which they are based. They are well known to pollute surrounding communities with chemical runoff and host military predators that sexually assault local women and girls. From the Pine Gap drone facility in Australia, to the Guantanamo Bay torture chamber in Cuba, to over 29 throughout Africa, 119 in Germany, 120 in Japan (including 15% of the land of Okinawa housing 90% of Okinawa's population) to five new US facilities opened this year in the Philippines, these bases much be shut down!

END US MILITARY AGREEMENTS

Stop the Growing US Influence in South Asia!

The US is attempting to consolidate allies in South Asia to secure its foothold in the region. India has been recruited by the US, Japan, and Australia into the Quadrilateral Security Dialogue (QUAD) to counter the rise of China, and in 2022 the US participated for the first time in the Indian-led MILAN multilateral naval exercise, considered India's premier international military exercise. India also joins Israel, the United Arab Emirates, and the US (I2U2) in technology sharing between each of these repressive regimes. US flood relief to Pakistan following the 2022 floods included the stipulation of new military assistance, an opportunistic move to force its way back into Pakistan, which it sees as a strategic staging ground for war. The financial meltdown and peoples' uprising in Sri Lanka represents an instability that the US might try to take advantage of to force a Western-friendly government back into the war torn county at the crossroads of Indian Ocean shipping lanes.



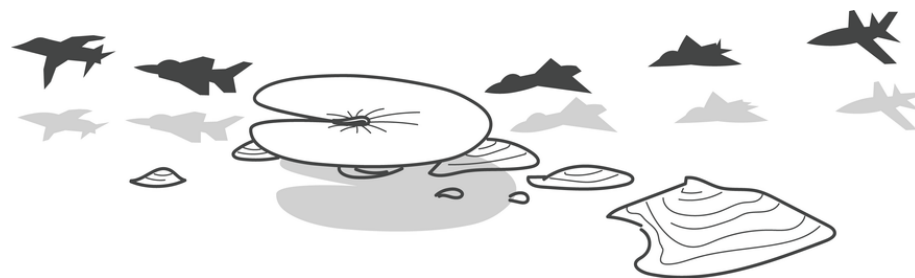
Frustrate the Growing US-Japan Tandem in the Indo-Pacific!

Japan is the US's most loyal ally in the Indo-Pacific. Military agreements forged after WWII enable the US to station more overseas troops here than in any other country in the region, with one-fifth of the land of Okinawa occupied by US bases. Right-wing governments successfully pushed for constitutional changes allowing Japan to re-arm for offensive purposes, leading to rising defense spending since 2007 and a doubling of the defense budget in 2023. In line with the US pivot to Asia, Japan is forging bilateral military agreements with neighboring countries like the Philippines and South Korea and being drawn into trilateral security agreements with the US and its allies directly to counter the rise of China. Japan will host the G7 Summit this year in Hiroshima, gathering the largest western economies in the US-imperialist alliance.

END JOINT MILITARY EXERCISES AND TRAININGS

End the Zionist Deadly Exchange!

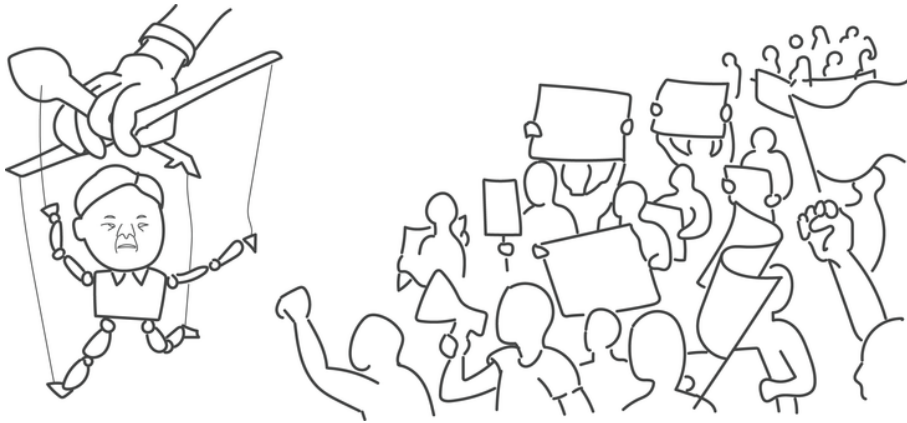
Israel systematically trains law enforcement agencies from around the world in the violent, repressive tactics the Zionist state uses to occupy Palestine and enforce military rule: a total surveillance state that monitors, restricts and infiltrates all aspects of Palestinians' lives both physical and virtual; systematic racial differentiation between Palestinians and Israeli Jews and blatant racial profiling, which leads to the labeling of Palestinians as enemy suspects and any act of dissent by Palestinians as "terrorism;" and repressive force against dissent; and use of force up to and including extrajudicial killings as the tactic of first-choice to respond to resistance. These exchange programs promote the use of the deadly tactics of state sponsored terror under the guise of counter-terrorism. The Israeli state "exports" Zionism in its racist training of police forces in the US and other white-dominated countries while training and arming colonial governments to enact similar settler projects to the occupation of Palestine, such as Morocco's colonization of Western Sahara and India's colonization of Kashmir.



Prepare to Cancel RIMPAC 2024!

Since 1971, The Rim of the Pacific (RIMPAC) games have been the world's largest international maritime exercises that includes combined operations and trainings conducted in and around the Hawaiian Island chain on a bi-annual basis. In 2022, over 25,000 military personnel, 38 ships, 170 aircraft, four submarines from 26 countries practiced war simulations engaging "enemy forces," in anti-air, anti-surface, anti-submarine, and electronic warfare operations, destroying the environment, increasing violence against local and native women, creating a strain on the islands' natural resources, justifying the continued poisoning of Oahu's aquifer by jetfuel, PFAs and other chemicals. RIMPAC dramatically contributes to the destruction of the ecology and aggravation of the climate crisis in the Pacific region, including through the routine destruction of decommissioned ships with missiles endangering marine mammals such as humpback whales, dolphins and Hawaiian monk seals and polluting the ocean with contaminants from the vessels.

STOP SUPPORT OF PUPPET AND PROXY REGIMES



Condemn Anti-People Coups and Proxy Wars in Africa!

Coups and counter-coups in Burkina Faso, Guinea, Chad and elsewhere in Africa have been influenced by the US's allies while Russia and China have taken advantage of the upheavals to win economic and military deals with repressive regimes. The US's arming of Ethiopia has influenced a brutal war in the Tigray region where the US's desire to see Eritrea destabilized and Somalia under its control prevents the demilitarization of the Horn of Africa. The US's silent support for the Moroccan occupation of Western Sahara allows for massive political repression of the indigenous Saharawi people for the potential to invest in Morocco-controlled industries in the country such as wind turbines and uranium mining.

Resist US Proxies in Central America and Refuse US-Led Intervention in Haiti!

US arming of repressive Central American regimes, in particular Guatemala and El Salvador, has increased due to the US's waning influence after pro-people and in some cases pro-China elections in South America. So-called "Wars on Gangs" by US puppet governments have killed thousands of land defenders and poor farmers to clear territory for mining interests. Both the US and Canada have threatened military intervention in Haiti to return a pro-Western leader and protect foreign investments in plantations and garment sweatshops and maintain US influence in the Caribbean.

Confront the Rise of Fascist Regimes in Asia!

The US "Pivot to Asia" has given fascism an open playing field across the continent. In the Pacific, the regimes of Yoon Suk Yeol in South Korea, Fumio Kishida in Japan and Ferdinand Marcos II in the Philippines have skyrocketed military spending, police power and unchecked vigilante violence to rise, all with massive US support. The regime of Narendra Modi in India has inspired ethno-religious pogroms on behalf of big agricultural interests as the US bribes the regime away from China's influence with technological investment. Turkey's anti-Kurd and anti-Syrian Erdogan regime unleashes state violence against its people and throughout the region, protected by its membership in NATO.

END SO-CALLED "COUNTER TERROR" WARFARE

Stop the Terror-Tagging of Freedom Fighters and Peace Advocates!

Under the War on Terror doctrine, imperialist and reactionary regimes around the world label peoples' movements and liberation struggles as "terrorist" in order to criminalize and suppress them. Palestinian, Filipino, Lebanese, Kurdish, Latin American, Indian, Irish, and other legitimate liberation movement organizations have been placed on the US and other terrorist lists with no transparency in how such determination is made, while nearly all Palestinian resistance organizations and political parties are labeled terrorist by the Israeli state, as are Kurdish organizations by various occupier states. International collusion between police departments, intelligence agencies and militaries has led to repression against peoples movements, including extrajudicial killings and imprisonment on trumped up charges of activists.

End all Drone Strikes!

Since the Obama presidency, there has been a massive increase in drone warfare, including the use of drones of mass destruction, notably in Kurdistan, Somalia,

Afghanistan, Syria, Yemen, Pakistan, the Philippines and across Western and Northern Africa. Drone warfare is inherently an oppressive and anti-people form of warfare, only possible through one state's use of superior technology and political power over another less powerful state or people. Drones kill ordinary citizens and are being designed to carry nuclear warheads and be directed by artificial intelligence. The US, Turkey, UK, Israel and France are among the largest manufacturers of drones.

Shut down Guantanamo Bay and all CIA Black Sites!

Since the "War on Terror" was declared in September 2001, the US has conducted counterterrorism operations in at least 85 countries, including through the use of so-called "Black Sites" where prisoners are disappeared without trial for torture-interrogation in locations never officially disclosed by the US or the governments hosting them. The largest of these detention sites is the infamous Guantanamo Bay, a US facility held on the island of Cuba without the consent of the Cuban government or people. In the FY 2024 budget, the Biden Administration requested nearly \$400 million for Counter-Islamic State funds alone, signaling that the disappearance and interrogation methods of the War on Terror are on track to continue without mass pressure to oppose them.

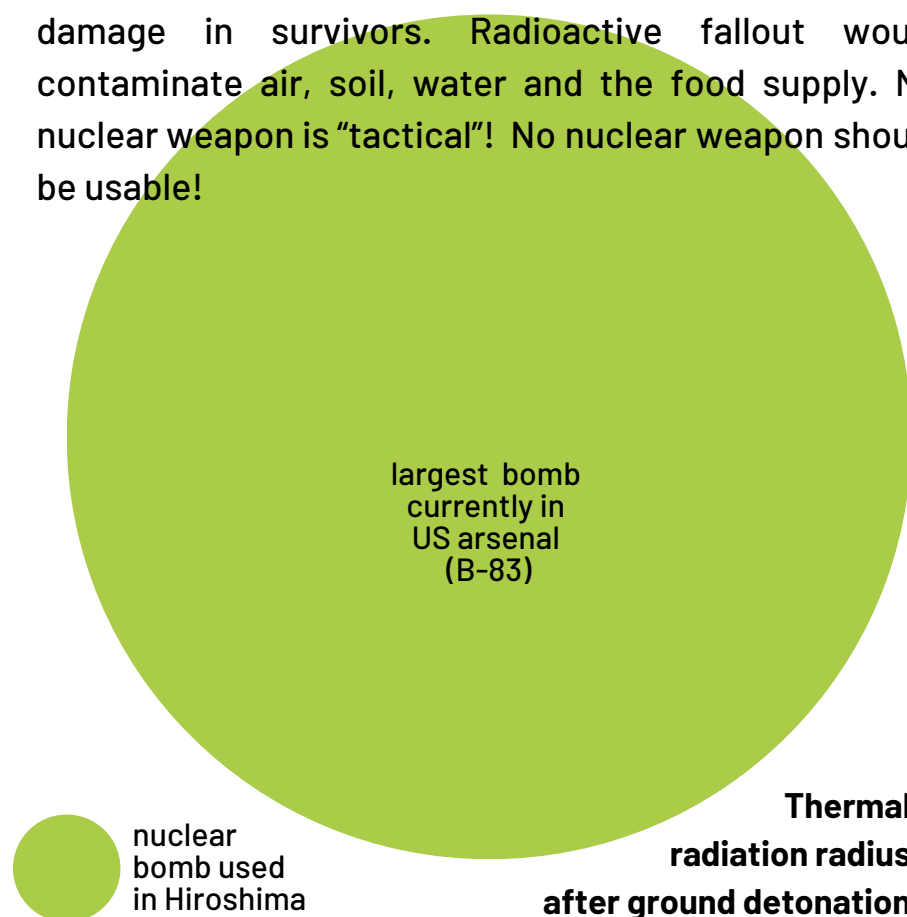
END THE NUCLEAR ARMS RACE

Demand the Nuclear Disarmament of Imperialist States Towards Complete Abolition!

US-led imperialists must lead the way or be forced to disarm as the first step. There were approximately 12,705 nuclear warheads worldwide as of January 2022 and almost 90 percent of them belong to two countries: the United States and Russia. While the US develops its over \$2 trillion nuclear modernization program, it plans to rebuild land, sea and air based nuclear weapons. The legacies of radiation exposure, contamination and health consequences due to the uranium mining, plutonium pit production, nuclear veterans and clean up veterans, weapons testing and in the case of Hiroshima and Nagasaki wartime use of nuclear weapons, should urge imperialist countries to scrap nuclear weapons and create genuine security for future generations. However, current imperialist rhetoric keeps the demand for the nuclear arms race high, and the risk of the US pulling out of the current nuclear non-proliferation treaties like New START would create conditions for the first time since the Cold War that the US would have no caps on its nuclear arsenal.

Oppose the Use of "Tactical Nukes" in Any Form

Tactical nuclear weapons exist because each side fears it would be deterred from using its big city-razing weapons by their very destructiveness. By making nuclear weapons smaller and the targeting more precise, their use becomes more thinkable. A tactical nuclear weapon would produce a fireball, shock waves, and deadly radiation that would cause long-term health damage in survivors. Radioactive fallout would contaminate air, soil, water and the food supply. No nuclear weapon is "tactical"! No nuclear weapon should be usable!



FIGHT WEAPONS COMPANIES AND ARMS SALES

Shut Down CANSEC 2023!

The CANSEC arms expo, North America's largest weapons and "defense industry" convention, brings 12,000 people, along with 55 international delegations, to Canada's capital, to meet and make deals with exhibitors including weapons manufacturers, military technology and supply companies, media outlets, and government agencies. The weapons companies sponsoring and exhibiting in CANSEC, including Boeing, Lockheed Martin and Northrop Grumman, rake in record billions in profits. The same conflicts around the world which have brought misery to millions have brought record profits to arms manufacturers.

Cut Ties with War Profiteers!

Transnational weapons companies (WTNCs) are corporations with global operations overseeing and gaining profits from the industrial mass production of high-tech weapons of war. They exist to profit from arming and re-arming state militaries to use in their wars against other countries or their own people. The five most powerful companies in the world are Lockheed Martin, Boeing, Raytheon Technologies, Northrop Grumman and General Dynamics, all centered in the US. They are complicit in the human rights violations and war crimes undertaken by aggressive state forces using their products.

STOP PRODUCTION OF HIGH TECH WARFARE

Expose the Co-optation of Research and Education Programs for the War Industry!

Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) university programs have consisted of between 36% and 54% of US weapons research throughout the various military branches since 2016. School programs have also been targeted by transnational weapons companies via scholarships and internship programs as a pipeline for students into the war industry. Working class students, students of color, women and LGBTQ students in particular are targeted through recruitment campaigns to build the weapons that will destroy the lives of their compatriots around the world. Education programs for collective empowerment are deprioritized to make way for pro-war programs that keep the US-led war machine running and weapons makers rich.

Halt Wasteful and Dangerous Weapons Development!

Weapons companies in the US and other industrial countries are developing extremely lethal new tools of

war. Laser technology, artificial intelligence, quantum computing, biotechnology, hypersonic propulsion and other sectors are geared away from pro-people and socially productive usages and into an unending spiral of war spending. The US's "nuclear modernization" program alone is \$505 billion with an existing stockpile of nearly 5,500 warheads. If left unchecked, this weapons development could have devastating impacts on civilians and the Earth as a whole.

Shut Down APEC 2023!

The Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) forum meetings will be hosted in the US throughout 2023. This elite and neoliberal gathering seek to complete the US-led Indo-Pacific Economic Framework (IPEF), a free trade agreement that would loosen corporate regulations and tighten intellectual property laws of corporations in over 40% of the global economy. This is geared particularly at helping the US seize control of semiconductor supply chains to increase its industrial base for weapons development. This agreement, if passed, will be a further provocative move towards China as the US seeks to monopolize investments in production and trade in the Indo Pacific.

END ECONOMIC WARFARE, FOOD BLOCKADES AND SANCTIONS

End the Blockade of Cuba!

For 61 years, Cuba has endured the longest-running economic blockade of any country in the world. According to the US State Department, the US expressly sought for the blockade to result in “economic dissatisfaction and hardship,” “hunger,” “desperation,” and “overthrow of government.” It is estimated that Cuba has suffered economic losses of \$1.39 trillion (accounting for inflation), as well as shortages of food, fuel, supplies and equipment and raw materials for the manufacturing of medicine.

End Militarized Land Grabs and Privatization Schemes that Starve the People’s Livelihood!

Land displacement of rural communities is a widespread effect of war, and oftentimes wars themselves are started in the interests of expanding corporate land ownership. In Ukraine, Western aid to support agriculture has been conditioned on structural adjustment programs that have sold over 200,000 small farmers’ land to a handful of oligarchs. Food aid given to war-stricken areas is funneled through local

bureaucrats or business owners to keep people relying on corrupt officials instead of their own self-sufficient production. Zionist settlers regularly destroy Palestinian farms and orchards in raids meant to capture more land for annexation by the occupation state. In every war, food and land are key to understanding the interests of warmakers.

Resist the Financial Hostage-Taking of Activists and Whole Nations!

The US has unilaterally enacted economic, financial, trade and other sanctions on individuals, organizations and over 40 countries as a means to force their compliance with US policies. Under the guise of utilizing a more “humane” approach to perceived threats to US interests, sanctions are essentially another form of warfare that imposes collective punishment on entire nations, most severely hurting civilians—especially people who are already impoverished. Sanctions block countries from accessing essentials including food, vaccines and medicine, medical supplies and resources needed for providing clean water, sanitation and health care, leading to people suffering and dying from malnutrition, starvation, and preventable illness. The unwillingness of the US to waive sanctions on countries like Venezuela and Iran prevented timely provision of the Covid-19 vaccine, prolonging and exacerbating the pandemic. Sanctions kill and are a tool of war.

END STATE REPRESSION

Defend the Right to Fight for Just Peace!

People around the world face intensified repression, including the State of Exception in El Salvador, Martial Law in the Philippines, the Countering Domestic Terrorism program in the US, use of chemical weapons by Turkey against the people of Kurdistan, deployment of the national guard in Puerto Rico, torture and illegal arrest of Palestinian political prisoners in occupied Palestine, extrajudicial killings and arrests of indigenous and campesino protests in Peru, and many other cases. Activists are tagged “Black Identity Extremists”, “terrorists” and other labels while murders by the police, even when video-recorded, go unpunished. We must build solidarity with people’s movements asserting their collective democratic rights, self-determination, and social and national liberation. Just and lasting peace must be fought for, and our movements must have each others’ backs.

Resist Racist Police Terror!

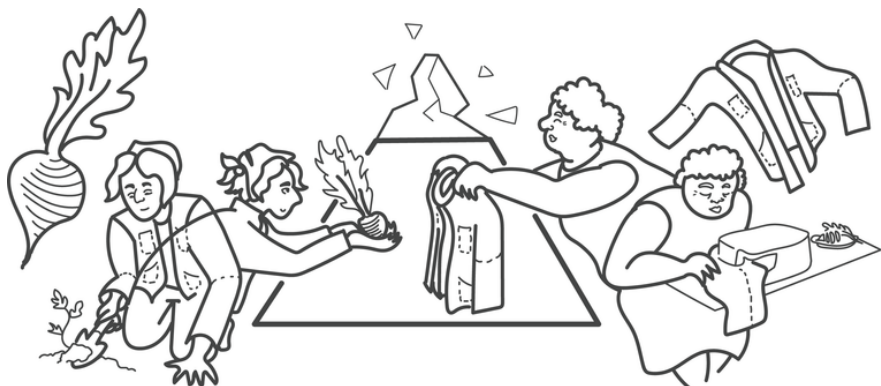
The U.S. police and military commit state sponsored murder and terror worldwide. There is blatant police occupation in such major urban areas as Atlanta (where the \$90 million, 85-acre “Cop City” training facility is being constructed), Baltimore, Chicago, Cleveland, Detroit, Los Angeles, Milwaukee, Minneapolis, New York, Oakland, St. Paul, St. Louis, Washington, D.C. and many others with police being permitted by city government to commit unspeakable crimes against the people. Black, Indigenous, Muslim and migrant communities as well as movements for Black liberation, indigenous decolonization and others face blatant racist violence. Israel and other repressive states conduct an active and ongoing “police exchange” program which has trained thousands of law enforcement officials how to brutalize innocent, unarmed people in the United States while the Federal 1033 program gifts military-grade gear to local police forces. White supremacy is and always has been an open tool of US-led war and repression, and it will exist until US imperialism is brought down.



CHALLENGE US MILITARY PRIORITIES

Demand Pro-People Alternatives!

The 2023 US military budget is officially \$816 billion and the 2024 budget is projected to be at least \$842. These numbers are in reality much higher when taking into consideration the budgets for other militarized departments like Homeland Security and the Department of Energy. US citizens are consistently left out of the conversation on the military budget, while weapons companies spent \$50 million on political candidates in 2020 to make sure their war profiteering interests are met. This has led to funding for education, healthcare, infrastructure and other social needs disappearing and ultimately privatizing over the years. Fighting for these social necessities requires fighting against the military priorities of the US state.



Stop Predatory Recruitment and Support the Rights of Veterans

Repressive militaries around the world utilize racist, chauvinistic and misogynist cultures of aggression to convince young people to enlist and fight, engendering cultures of militaristic individualism over international solidarity. They lie or bribe with benefits like education tuition or skills training that often don't serve recruits as veterans in society. Veterans in repressive militaries are widely mistreated, with over 33,000 houseless veterans in the US alone, demonstrating how little imperialist and other repressive states truly value the people fighting their wars on their behalf.

Fight Towards a Global System for Just Peace!

The current profit and war oriented system of governance in the US and around the world is the number one barrier to world peace. As heroic as reform-based political campaigns are, the system itself must be challenged and rebuilt from the grassroots up. We need justice, social equity, and solidarity amongst peoples, including the recognition of the right to self-determination, economic, and food sovereignty, and self-defense of nations and oppressed peoples from reactionary aggression and violence. Build peace through genuine sustainable development, job creation, and the health and well being of our communities.

JOIN THE RESIST US-LED WAR MOVEMENT!

How the campaign came about

The 2023 Anti-Militarism Agenda is the first of its kind! In 2022, Resist took part in a months-long campaign titled "Fight Against Imperialist Wars" in which organizers held a 24-hour global anti-war action, mobilized to Europe against the 2022 NATO Summit and culminated on International Peace Day, challenging the United Nations concept of disingenuous "peace" under the current imperialist system. Lessons learned during this campaign inspired Resist to compile into one document the key grassroots organizing tactics for a united anti-war movement in a given year.
